

General Class Descriptions - Alpha Track

Drama – No experience necessary. Learn fundamentals of drama and basic acting skills.

Drumming – (15) Explore drums and rhythms. Drums and instruments are provided.

Guitar I - (15) Bring your own guitar. For those with little or no guitar experience.
